Introduction:

The theme of the 2010 NITSL Workshop is:

Nuclear Safety: Setting the Global IT Standard

The role of IT is ever increasing in importance as it relates to the safe, reliable and efficient operation of our nuclear power plants. The proposed theme emphasizes the importance of IT in maintaining business continuity with our plants and the positive impact that NITSL, plant IT/Engineering leadership, and the vendor community is having on the nuclear industry not to mention the potential for greater impacts in the future.

This theme would provide an excellent opportunity for all to highlight some of the business enabling IT solutions deployed as a result of needs identified by plant customers.

NITSL covers four core focus areas:

- Cyber Security
- Process Computing/Plant Technology Solutions
- Infrastructure & Applications

Vendor Workshop Details:

NITSL invites the vendor community to participate in the NITSL 2010 Workshop. NITSL is offering the vendor community the ability to attend the NITSL Workshop as long as they are an exhibiting vendor at Vendor Night. The on line Vendor Registration Form on the NITSL website, www.NITSL.org, contains registration fee information.

Due to the sensitive nature of the information that might be presented in the Cyber Security Track, NITSL reserves the right to make vendor attendance in the Cyber Security Track by invitation. At this time it is the intent of NITSL to maintain the Cyber Security Track open to all who register to attend.

Vendor Night Details:

Wednesday July 14th, from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

The membership of NITSL is interested in balancing the information we receive with vendor interfaces concerning products, services, and views of interest to our membership. It is for this reason that we are interested in your participation. The format of our vendor night allows us to offer to our members an evening of informal displays and discussions with selected vendors.

We invite you to participate in an opportunity to present and/or demonstrate your product, services, or views at our 2010 Vendor Night. The cost to you is a nominal fee of \$1495.00.

What you get for the fee:

- The fee allows for each vendor to register two people to attend the Vendor Night, Wednesday 5:00 PM – 8:00 PM 07/14/2009, and the Workshop 07/13-15/2010. Additional Booth Workers are \$395.00 ea and they are also allowed to attend the Workshop activities. Breakfast, Lunch, & Breaks are included during the Workshop.

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- The opportunity to market to all of the major Nuclear Utilities in one night in a relaxed atmosphere.
- A 10 foot by 10 foot booth area that will include a 6 foot table and AC power. If you have a booth display that can fit into this area, feel free to bring it.
- Upon verification of participation, your company's web site will be linked from the "LINKS" page of the NITSL web site (www.nitsl.org) as a Workshop sponsor until the next NITSL Workshop. The Links page is maintained in the Member Only section of the NITSL web site. Please provide me with a brief, 70 words, description of your company and a link you would like to take potential utility customers to Gregory.Przyjemski@trmnet.com. Provide this information even if you did so in the past.
- Recognition in the NITSL Workshop Handbook. The 70 word description from above will be included along with contact information of those attending the Workshop and your company logo. Provide your company logo to Gregory Przyjemski at the email address provided above.
- The fee is used to pay for the use of the facility and provide food and cocktails for everyone in attendance at the Vendor Night as well as cover the food and workshop expenses associated with attending the NITSL Workshop.
- We also invite the vendors to attend the NITSL Registration/Welcome reception on Monday July 12th from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM to spend time networking and socializing with the membership and other vendors. The Welcome Reception will be held at the Charleston Marriott Hotel where all of the activities will take place.
- The vendor night has been very successful for both NITSL and Vendors. We have quite a few Vendors that come to every Vendor Night offered. The last two years we sold out vendor night and had to turn vendors away. Don't miss this opportunity by putting off registration.

In order to encourage maximum attendance and vendor member interaction, we are asking each vendor to bring a gift to be raffled off from names of those who attend the exhibit. Each vendor will be responsible for a collection point at their booth for names to be drawn. We will draw names toward the end of the evening. There will be one prize per person. This is designed to produce more winners by eliminating duplicate winners, and keep people around for the entire event since they must be present to win. Vendors can not enter these raffles. This year we will allow a person to trade their prize if their name is picked more than once. If the person is picked more than once, they can elect to keep what they have and another name is picked, or accept the prize offered and another name will be picked to raffle off the prize that was turned over. The raffle goes over big at all of the Vendor Nights. There is no limit to the value of the prize, but the average value has been around \$150. By no means do you have to spend that much, but vendors always ask for a number.

Registration at the Workshop is either at the Welcome reception Monday July 12 from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM or the Mornings of July 13 & 14 outside the Workshop conference room.

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Your booth area is 10 foot wide and 10 foot deep. Your booth is expected to stay within that area unless you want to rent more than one booth space.

Each Vendor will be provided a 6 foot by 30 inch table covered with linens. You could have the table removed if you so chose.

There will be outlets around the room to provide power, if you need more than the typical amps, you will have to arrange that with the hotel personnel.
